

Cassville's Mississippi Market Pet Policy

Service Dogs will always be allowed in the Cassville's Mississippi Market, as required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. In addition, patrons of the Market are welcome to bring their beloved pets to the Market in accordance with the guidelines below:

1. All pets must be kept on a short, non-expandable leash.
2. Always keep your pet under control and by your side.
3. Keep pets away from vendor products, baked goods, produce, plants, ready to eat foods and other food.
4. Come prepared to clean up after your pet! Owners must clean up any pet products. This means anything that comes out of the mouth and/or tail end!
5. If your pet is witnessed urinating on any product or person, the pet owner will be responsible for covering the cost of the product, damage or any medical/hospital expenses incurred as a result of the incident.
6. Your pet must be sociable and orderly while around people and other pets. Your pet is not allowed to jump on other people or approach other pets to earn the right to attend the Market.
7. Never introduce your pet to another pet without the owner's consent.
8. Not everyone is a pet lover. Be considerate and respectful in your surroundings. Don't allow your pet to jump on other people.
9. Pet owners are liable for any injury or damage caused by your pet. By bringing your pet to the Market, you agree to hold harmless and agree to cover costs for any injury or damage caused by your pet.
10. If a pet is not behaving in accordance with these rules, the Market staff or volunteers have the right to ask the owner to remove the pet immediately.
